- III. - IV. Supplemental Agreement No. 18 to PSA No. 1252, with UES Professional Solutions for testing and inspection of materials for various landslide construction projects at St. Louis Lambert International Airport, in the amount of \$25,000.00. This supplemental agreement modifies the scope of work and is authorized by Ordinance Nos. 71657 and 71876.
- V. Supplemental Agreement No. 19 to PSA No. 1252, with UES Professional Solutions for testing and inspection of materials for various landslide construction projects at St. Louis Lambert International Airport, in the amount of \$15,000.00. This supplemental agreement modifies the scope of work and is authorized by Ordinance No. 71657.
